What to do when someone dies

From the 9th September 2024

Following a death and after being notified the Doctor will complete the cause of death certificate (MCCD) this will then be emailed by the GP to a medical examiner along with the deceased medical records. The medical examiner will look at all the information and will speak with the NOK/family and go through the medical notes. Once satisfied the Medical Examiner will then send the MCCD to the registrar and will inform the NOK/family so that they can then ring the registrars to make an appointment.

When someone dies at home

Contact your own Doctor or on call Doctor, district nurse or terminal care nurse. When one of these medical professionals have verified the death, please contact ourselves, no matter what the time of day, we are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When you are ready two members of our staff will then bring your loved one into our care.

When someone dies in hospital

The bereavement office from the hospital will be in contact with you, you no longer collect the death certificate from the hospital. Once the hospital informs us that all the paperwork is complete, we will then bring your loved one into our care.

When someone dies at a nursing home

The staff may be qualified to confirm that death has taken place or alternatively the home will arrange for a doctor to visit. Once the death has been confirmed, the home or yourselves can contact us to make the arrangements for bringing your loved one into our care at any time, day or night.

When someone dies unexpectedly

If a death is unexpected or the deceased has not been seen by their doctor recently, the coroner may need to be involved. The Coroner's duty is to investigate all sudden and unexpected deaths. This may include a post mortem examination to establish the cause of death and an inquest; we will guide you along with the Coroner's officer at all times through the process.

Registering a Death

When visiting the registrars it is advisable to take the birth certificate, marriage or civil partnership certificate, passport and NHS medical card although this is not essential.

You will need to tell the registrar:

- the person's full name at the time of death
- any names previously used, eg maiden name
- the person's date and place of birth
- their last address
- their occupation
- the full name, date of birth and occupation of a surviving or late spouse or civil partner
- whether they were getting a State Pension or any other benefits

Being conveniently situated next door to the registrars in Milton Road South, Stowmarket, this enables you, if you so wish, to visit the registrars and make the funeral arrangements at our homely style office, in one visit. You are more than welcome to park your car at our office. Alternatively if it is more convenient for you we can make the funeral arrangements in the comfort of your own home.

There are many options available to personalise the funeral including high quality stationery such as service sheets, personalised pew cards, memorial cards, books of condolence, photoboard etc.

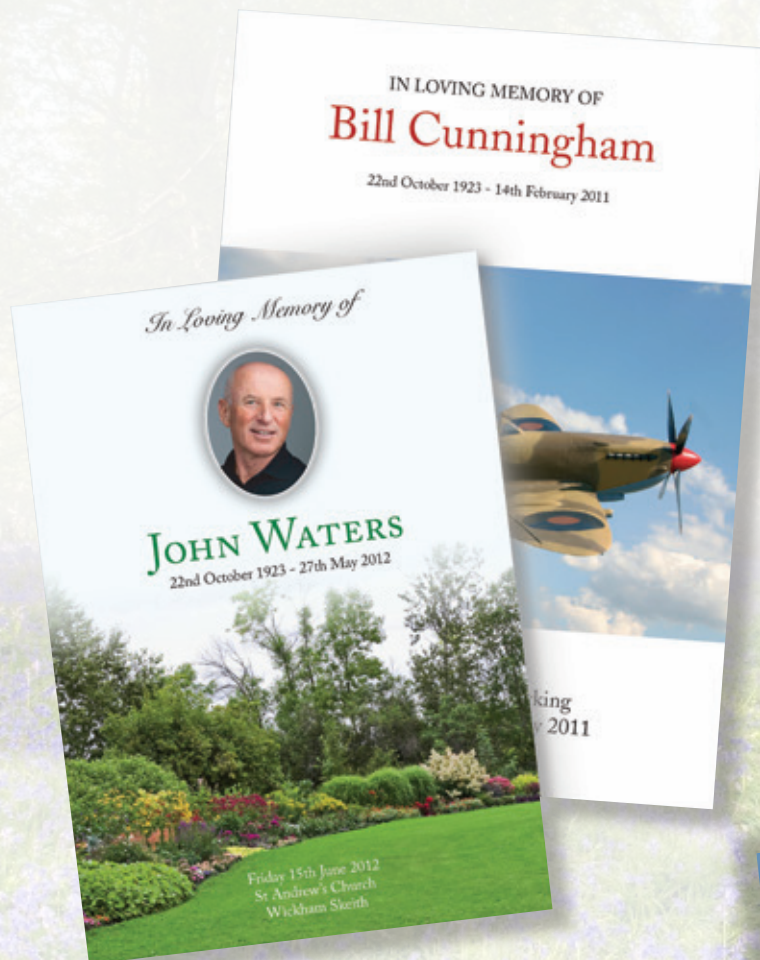


Order of Service Sheets

Our A5 order of service sheets are printed on quality paper and card. The covers are printed on card and the inner pages on paper. Plain white or cream tinted options are available.

Choose your cover design from the options shown in our brochure. Alternatively a bespoke design can be created. These are available in black and white or colour designs (colour can also be used on the inner pages if required).

If you would like a picture to be added to the service sheet, you can either provide it digitally or we can scan a photograph at our office.



You do not have to worry about the actual content of the service sheet, we will liaise with the person taking the funeral service.

Once the service sheet has been designed we will provide a proof for you and any changes, if required, can be made.

We can also provide photo boards and books of condolence which are uniquely designed for you.

Music

You can personalise the funeral to include a favourite piece of music perhaps as the coffin enters the chapel, during the service and at the end of the service.

Alternatively we can organise for a live musician.

Eulogy

A member of the family, friend or colleague may like to pay a tribute at the funeral. It is advisable to discuss the length and content of the tribute with the officiant; it is also advisable that the tribute should be typed out, just in case the person feels too overwhelmed to read it out, in which case the officiant can then say it on their behalf.

Funeral Catering

We can either organise with local hotels, public houses, community centres and village halls for refreshments after the funeral service or we can arrange for outside catering (who use locally sourced food) to be provided at a private venue or your own home. Whatever your requirements, we are here to help.

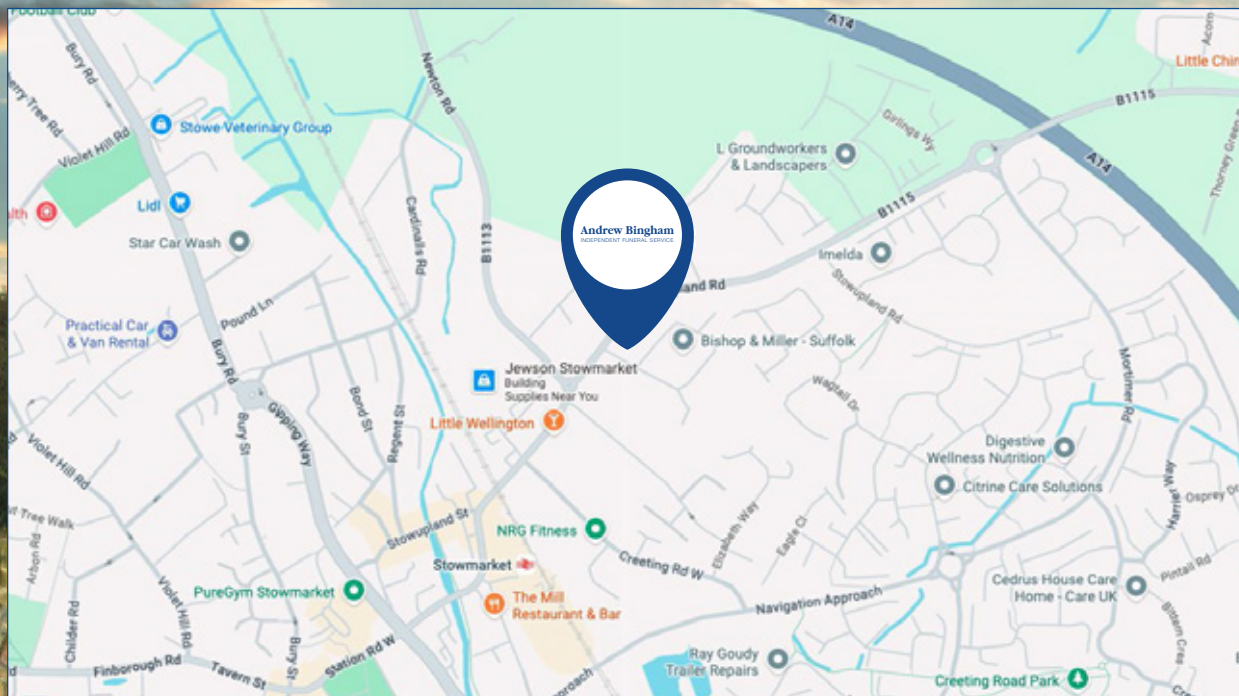
